Evan Peters shot a final round 73 to finish one over par and claim medalist honors in the SCSU Husky Classic held Sunday and Monday at the St. Cloud Country Club. Peters shot even par in the first round and was tied for third two strokes behind the leader. His steady second round gave him a one stroke win over Jordan Dockter of Minnesota State.

OTHER WOMEN'S GOLF TOP PERFORMERS

Bemidji State's Marissa Mackedanz (Jr., Paynesville, Minn.) was the Beavers' top performers at the Wildwood Lodge Invitational where she posted an 83-96--179 (+35) and freshman Kathryn Stoffels (Maple Grove, Minn.) who shot a 89-90--179 (+35), to finish in a tie for 49th place. The Beavers took 11th in the event with a two-day total of 358-368--726 (+150).

Concordia-St. Paul's Laura Petterson (Fr., Lakeville, Minn.) finished the Wildwood Lodge Invitational with a score of 163, +19 par and in a tie for 14th place. Petterson was the only CU golfer to shoot under 80 throughout the tournament. The freshman came on strong in round 2 improving on her 1st round score by 11 strokes. She shot a 76 today, after shooting an 87 during the 1st round of play.

Upper Iowa's Jill Preeshl led the Peacocks in the Wildwood Lodge Invitational on Monday. She rebounded from a day one 81 to shoot a 74 on day two for third place. McKenzie Holthaus (76-86) and Calie Trusler (80-82) tied for 12th place as each golfer put together 36-hole totals of 162, while Laura Taylor shot a 79 on day two to climb the leaderboard and finish in a tie for 14th with a 163. The Peacocks were one of thirteen teams competing in the tournament hosted by the University of Concordia, St. Paul. The tournament was played on campus at the Tartan Park Golf Course in Lake Elmo, Minnesota. The Peacocks turned in a 321 on their first day of action and another 321 on day two, which earned the team a 3rd place finish. The Peacocks finished just three strokes behind team champion Winona State and just a stroke behind runner up Nebraska-Omaha.

OTHER MEN'S GOLF TOP PERFORMERS

Bemidji State's Chris Curb (Fr., Bemidji, Minn.), the reigning NSIC Co-Men's Golfer of the Week, was three-over, with a score of 70-77--147, finishing in a tie for third. His round of 70 on day one was the fifth-consecutive round under par. He paced a BSU team to a third place finish (294-306--600, +24) at the SCSU Husky Classic.

Concordia-St. Paul's John Potter (Fr., Woodbury, Minn.) was consistent from one day to the next for CU at the St. Cloud State University Husky Classic. Potter shot a 77 in both rounds for a total score of 154, +10 par. The freshman was competing as an individual in the tournament and his score would not count towards the team score.

Northern State's Alex Osowski (Jr., Princeton, Minn. / Princeton HS) led the Wolves in their participation at the SCSU Husky Classic on Sunday and Monday with a +7 score of 151 (77, 74) that placed him in a tie for 11th place out of 90 total competitors. The Wolves as a team finished in 11th place with a team score of 631, earning a 316 on the first day and bettering their first-day score by a stroke on the second day with 315.

The Upper Iowa men's golf team completed their play in St. Cloud, Minnesota on Monday in the St. Cloud State University Husky Classic at the St. Cloud Country Club. The Peacocks put together a first round score of 315 and followed on day two with a . The Peacocks finished in tenth place. Thomas Guyer led the Peacocks in the tournament with a pair of 77's to finish in a tie for 25th place. Jake Nelson shot a 76 in the first round, but struggled on day two to finish with a 159. Tyler Pederson also shot a 159 to round out UIU's top three in St. Cloud.
